Small Universe Threshold Exception.

While data must be reported, in an effort to not arbitrarily exclude programs from the list that serve a small universe of students, performance levels will be considered met if a program serves less than ten (10) students in either population for WIA/WIOA and/or All. If the population for each is less than ten (10), all performance measures will be waived.

For example, if the WIA/WIOA population of a program is seven (7) and the All population is thirty-six (36); the program will need to meet four (4) out of the five (5) All population measures and will be exempted from the WIA/WIOA measures.

If the WIA/WIOA population of a program is six (6) and the All population is nine (9); the program will not need to meet any of the measures and will be exempted from both the All and WIA/WIOA population measures.
