Pennsylvania College of Technology will offer the Advanced Manufacturing Pre-Apprenticeship (AMP) Program for high school juniors and seniors beginning January 2026.

The four-month AMP program is a career exploratory program that provides students with an understanding of the foundational technical training and career paths in the 21st-century manufacturing industry.

AMP Pre-apprentices . . .

- Learn foundational technical knowledge and skills that will prepare them for entry-level employment in a variety of manufacturing occupations
- Earn the Certified Manufacturing Associate industry certification
- Network with manufacturing employers in a variety of fields
- Are eligible to enter a Penn College registered apprenticeship program (Mechatronics, Industrial Manufacturing Technician, CNC Operator) in partnership with a manufacturing employer

- 3 in-person, hands-on lab days at the Penn College Campus or another designated location
- Industry Day Your opportunity to meet Manufacturing Employers
